And between the throne and the four living creatures and among the elders I saw a Lamb standing, as though it had been slain, with seven horns and with seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God sent out into all the earth. 'And when he had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each holding a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. And they sang a new song, saying, "Worthy are you to take the scroll and to open its seals, for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation, and you have made them a kingdom and priests to our God, and they shall reign on the earth." Revelation 5:8-10

- Exalted saints who have died and gone to heaven (white robes, crowns and thrones)?
- Exalted saints in heaven after the rapture?
- Heavenly beings in the divine council (elohim)?

- 5:8 Holding bowls of the prayers of the saints (they are not saints).
- 5:9, 10 They refer to the redeemed as "them" not "us".
- 7:13, 14 They talk about the multitude of the redeemed and are not part of the multitude.
- Divine council in Daniel 7:9, 10, 26 and Psalm 82:1 and elsewhere.

Son of man dominion like the scroll

"I saw in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven there came one like a son of man, and he came to the Ancient of Days and was presented before him.
