Tribulation θλίψις (thlipsis 2347) afflicted (be) [KJV] pressure, affliction, anguish From E.W Bullinger Lexicon


> 'These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.' John 16:33




Usage of "Tribulation"

> 'And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not troubled; for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines, pestilences, and earthquakes in various places. All these are the beginning of sorrows [birth pains].' Matthew 24:6-8

Cosmic Disturbances



Great Tribulation Cut Short for the Elect



Usage of "Tribulation"

- The entire 70th Week is never called "the Tribulation" in the Bible.
- The "great tribulation" begins after the abomination of desolation, the mid-point.
- This "great tribulation" is "cut short". The 70th Week is not cut short.
- > It is cut short when the son of man comes on the cloud to rescue the elect.

5th Seal Great Tribulation

> 'When He opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the testimony which they held. And they cried with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?" Then a white robe was given to each of them; and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer, until both the number of their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed as they were, was completed.' Revelation 6:9-11

6th Seal Cosmic Disturbances

> 'I looked when He opened the sixth seal, and behold, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became like blood. And the stars of heaven fell to the earth, as a fig tree drops its late figs when it is shaken by a mighty wind. 
